Banner Health at a glance


- One of the largest non profit health systems in the country

- Almost 50,000 employees

- Rapidly evolved from a hospital system to an integrated delivery system
- Expanding access to care through health centers, clinics, urgent care sites and retail pharmacies.

Innovations - Neighborhood Physician Alliance




Formed from the merging of two local well-respected physician organizations - Arizona Integrated Physicians and Banner Physician Hospital Organization. <u>These organizations ceased operations on 12/31/16</u> and as of January 1, 2017 became Neighborhood Physician Alliance.



Neighborhood Physician Alliance has:

- Established eight distinct neighborhoods of care.
- Full spectrum of primary care, specialty care and ancillary services.
- Providers are aligned with the neighborhoods based upon office location.
- Most neighborhoods include at least one Banner Medical Center.
- Banner Urgent Care Centers are located in each Neighborhood.
- Neighborhoods have the ability to access all Banner resources.

MSSP and Banner

- BHN participated in **Pioneer** 2012-2016.
- Transitioned to MSSP Track 3 in 2017
- ~50,000 aligned lives in Maricopa County
- ~ 550 Phoenix primary care providers participating (50% employed/50% NPA)
- Participating in 3-day waiver
- Banner Network Colorado (northern Colorado) is participating in CPC+ and MSSP
 Track 2. About 12,000 aligned lives.



- Other CMMI programs throughout Banner:
 - Banner Medical Group (Phoenix and Tucson) in partnership with MD Anderson participate in Oncology Care Model
 - 2 hospitals participate in BPCI considering BPCI-A for other hospitals (10/1/18)
 - 9 Maricopa County Banner hospitals partnered with DaVita to participate in ESCO (ESRD program).
